Duration 1 hour

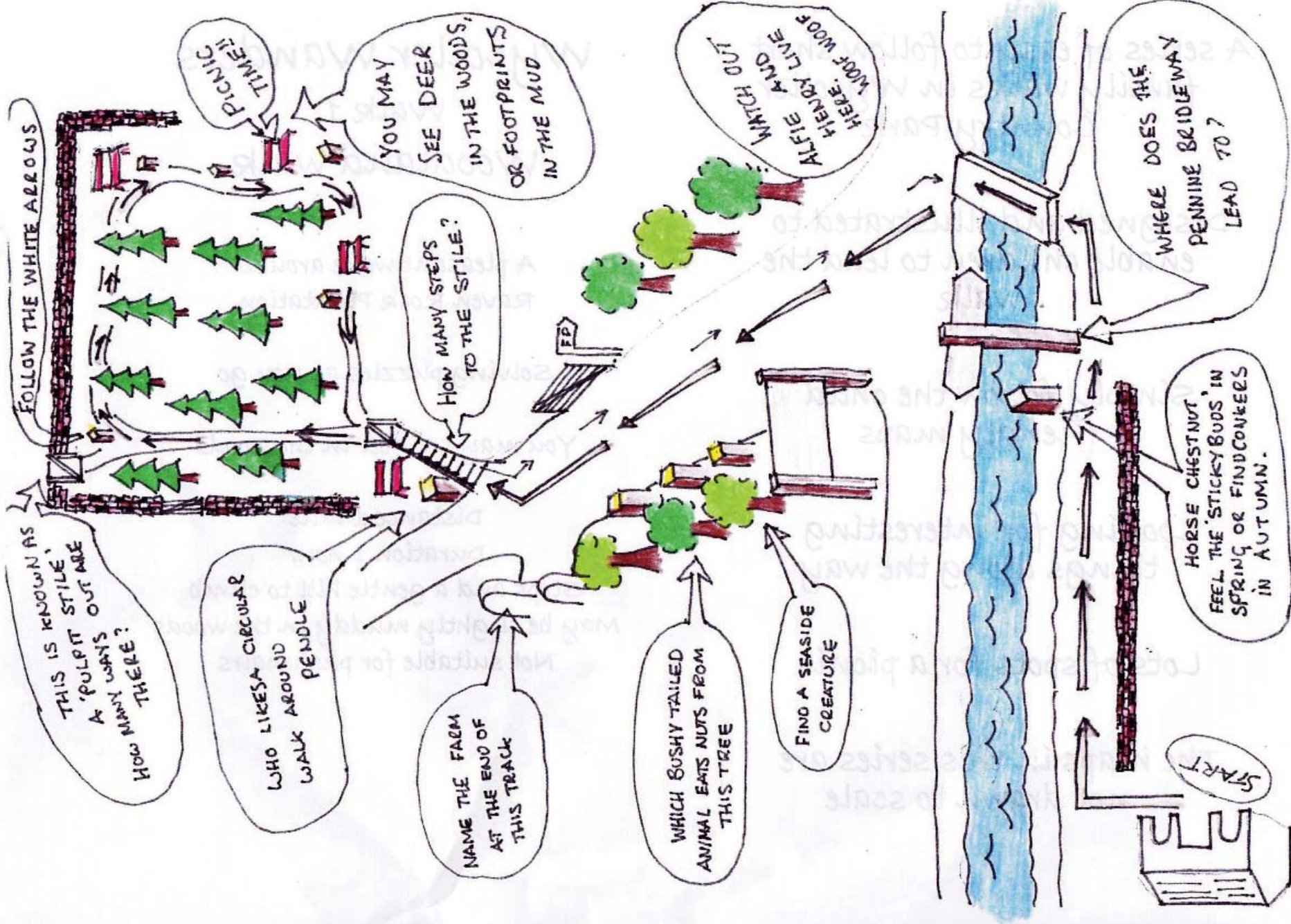
A pleasant walk around Raven Rock Plantation
